



Installing CC4 Anywhere (Linux)

What it does

CC4 Anywhere lets you connect to your school or college network using many kinds of computing device. You can use programs from a computer where they aren't even installed, and do your work wherever and whenever you want – not just at your school or college, but from anywhere you can use the Internet.

Not using Linux?

Installing CC4 Anywhere QuickStart guides are available for other platforms, e.g. Microsoft® Windows®, Apple Mac, and various mobile phone/PDA operating systems. Ask your network administrator or teacher for the version you need.

What you need to use CC4 Anywhere

- A computer (desktop, laptop or other mobile computing device) that runs the Linux® operating system.
- A wired or wireless connection to the Internet.
- A CC4 network username and password.
- If possible you should install the **CC4 Anywhere Web client** program. To do this you need permission to install programs on your computing device (you need 'administrative rights'). Normally, if it's your own computer, you will be allowed to do this. If you aren't allowed to install programs on the computer you're using, try the **Java client** (overpage).

1. Download the CC4 Anywhere Web client

1 Connect your computer to the Internet and log on.

2 Open your browser (e.g., Mozilla® Firefox®) and browse to your CC4 Anywhere website. (Your network administrator or teacher can give you the address.)

3 At the logon page, type in your network Username and Password. Click **Log On**.

4 Click **Download**.

Can't download? Try the Java client (overpage).

5 Choose **Save to Disk**. Click **OK ...** and then **Save**.

6 Close the **Downloads** window. **Do not** click **Continue**.

7 Run File Manager. Open **My Documents**. Right-click in an empty space and choose **New Folder ...**

8 ... and re-name it **CC4 Anywhere**.

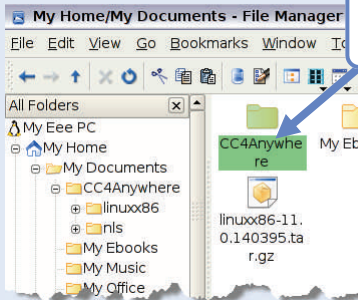
9 Right-click on the file you saved, and choose **Extract All**.

10 Select the **CC4 Anywhere** folder and click **OK**.

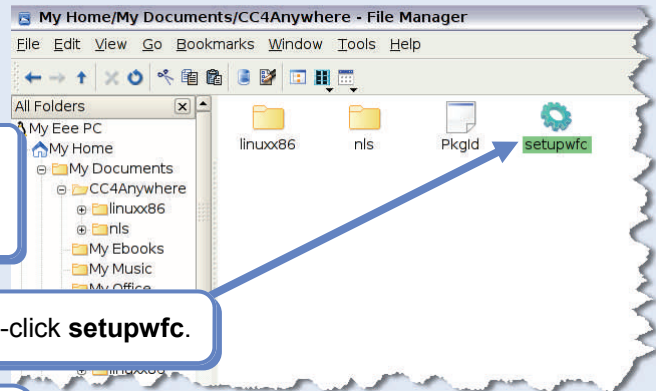

2. Install the CC4 Anywhere client

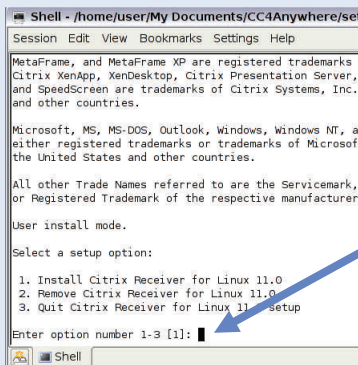
With My Documents open in File Manager ...



1 Double-click on the **CC4 Anywhere** folder to open it.



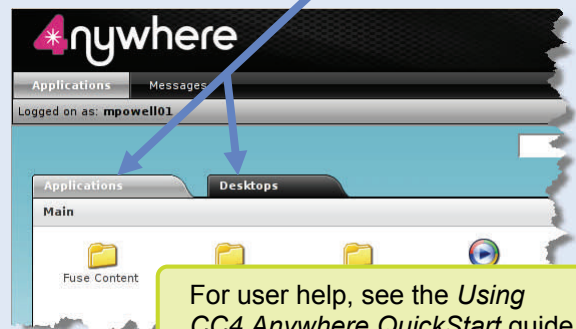
2 Double-click **setupwfc**.



3 At the 9 prompts, type in the following:

- 1 1 <Enter>
- 2 <Enter>
- 3 <Enter>
- 4 y <Enter>
- 5 1 <Enter>
- 6 <Enter>
- 7 <Enter>
- 8 3 <Enter>
- 9 <Enter>

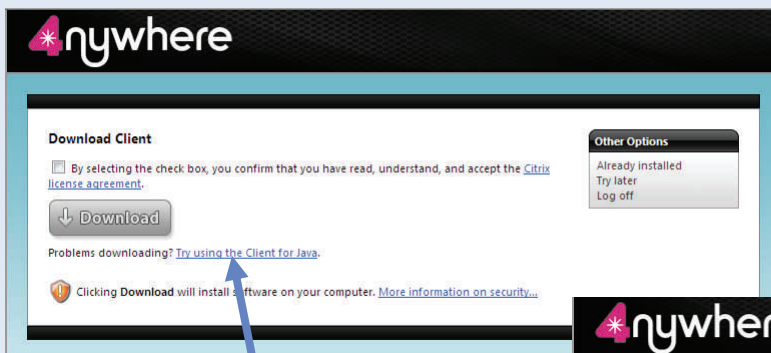
4 Restart your machine. Browse to your CC4 Anywhere website again (log in if necessary). You can now use CC4 Anywhere.

Using the client for Java

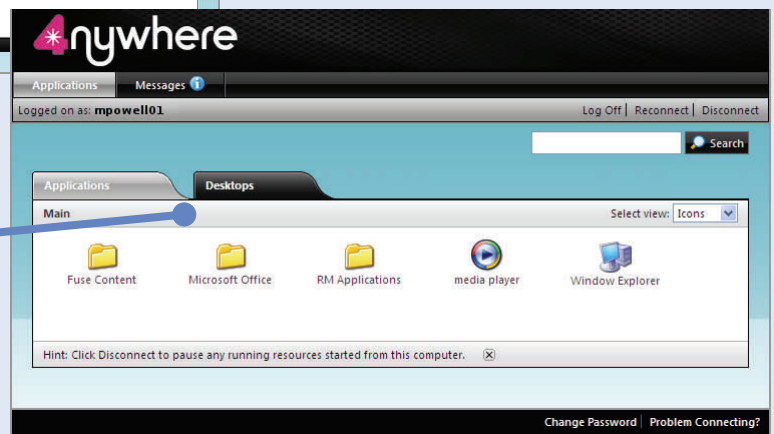
If you don't have permission to install the CC4 Anywhere client on the computer you're using, you can probably still get CC4 Anywhere using the Java client.



1 Click **Try using the Client for Java.***

2 That's it – your CC4 applications (programs) and desktop(s) are ready to use.

*If you **can't** see the **Try using the Client for Java** link, it means that 'Java Runtime Environment' hasn't been installed on your computer. Without it you can't use the Java client.
