GCSE results in summer 2008 – 77% A*-C

A2 results are at 98% on the 'A' level courses with 10 pupils on A2 and 12 pupils on AS.

In September 2009 all year 10 pupils will be taking the BTEC Level 2 First Certificate in Sport.

Extra curricular activities are very successful in a wide range of activities across the city and nationally. We have recently been involved in the Junior Sports Leaders Award (JLSA) with 100 Year 10 pupils choosing this within core PE.
